



## EMBLEEMA MISSION STATEMENT

March 8, 2018

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The Embleema Healthcare Network Consortium regroups patient advocacy groups, care centers, pharmaceutical and medtech companies, CROs, telco and cloud providers, and patient app developers willing to pilot the healthcare blockchain network with real-life patients in an open ecosystem environment.

Enterprises joining the Consortium are required to host at least one node in the healthcare blockchain and need to be compliant as regards to privacy regulations (e.g. HIPAA in the US, GDPR in Europe).

Embleema will provide in an open-source and free-of-charge manner the code base to provision healthcare blockchain nodes, as well as smart-contracts to develop patient apps on the blockchain.

The Consortium will be governed by its members through the Consortium Board. A Consortium Steering Committee where each member is represented will provide guidance to four workgroups : real-world data, patient and provider, privacy and ethics, technical. Participation in the workgroups by the members is on a « best-effort » basis. Embleema will provide day-to-day project management and logistical support to run the Consortium.

The Consortium is planned to launch in second quarter 2018 after the commercial launch of the Embleema healthcare blockchain network and will run the pilot for one year.

A first use case for gathering real-world data for patients included in clinical trials is being discussed with several care centers and pharma companies both in the U.S. and Europe.
